

Wyclif School Uniform (K5- Year 11)

At WICS we aim to have a high standard of dress and appearance for both pupils and staff. Pupils and staff should always try to dress smartly and modestly, and behave in a way that honours God, their school and their family. The following is a list of appropriate school uniform.

Winter/Spring Term

Boys: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Black or grey school trousers.▪ White shirt and school tie (available from school office) for Years 4-11.▪ Lower Primary (K5-Year 3) students should wear a white polo shirt without a tie.▪ Plain burgundy jumper or black blazer (no hooded jumpers).▪ Black or grey socks.▪ Black school shoes.	Girls: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Burgundy, knee-length skirt.▪ Pinafore dresses are also acceptable for primary students (K5 – Year 6).▪ White shirt and school tie for Years 4-11.▪ Lower Primary (K5-Year 3) students should wear a white polo shirt without a tie.▪ Plain burgundy jumper or black blazer (no hooded jumpers).▪ Black or burgundy tights/socks.▪ Black school shoes or boots.
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- Students may wear clothing underneath their school uniform but it should not be visible.

Alternative Summer Term and September Uniform

Boys: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Grey school shorts.▪ White polo shirt.	Girls: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ White polo shirt.▪ White ankle socks.▪ Pale pink/red checked dress (Primary only).
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Sports Kit (boys and girls)

<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Loose navy shorts or loose track suit/jogging bottoms.▪ Plain white polo shirt.▪ White or black socks.▪ Trainers with non-marking soles.▪ Plain navy hoody or jumper. (logos should be small)▪ Plain burgundy school jumpers may also be worn.
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Sixth Form School Uniform (Years 12-13 only):

<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Black school trousers or black school skirt.▪ White school shirt with school sixth form tie or white polo in summer term.▪ Black shoes.▪ Black blazer, jumper or cardigan (no hooded jumpers).▪ Sports kit is the same as above.
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All clothing should be clearly labelled for easy identification. Sensible coats and bags are advised. Primary school book bags in the school's colours with logo are available via the office.

Hair should be clean, neat and, if necessary, tied back so it does not fall across the face. Any hair ties etc should be burgundy or black. Hairstyles should be conservative, and hair should not be dyed a non-natural hair colour. Watches may be worn but no other jewellery should be visible. Girls may wear plain ear studs but earrings are not acceptable for boys. Make up and coloured nail varnish should not be worn.
